After several rounds of kisses and jackpots- I needed to go outside for a moment, emotionally exhausted from this long journey we have been on. I have asked a lot from My Girl. Her PUDX career has been so fun with exceptional highs and these last legs some great comedy with Windy adding a lot of creativity to her performances but also serious pushing up hill.

Rotties are considered veterans at age 7 and at 8 years old, Windy is tired of being judged. For 20 years, my goal has been to have a UDX Rottie. Windy has rewarded me twice over- with a "P" for "close enough to **P**erfect for me!"

Windy is now retired from obedience working for fun and fitness but we will start a new career in nose work really soon!

We are giving the Glenbard mugs with poop bags inside for all Beginner Novice A and Novice A entries. Also for all Rally Novice A entries.

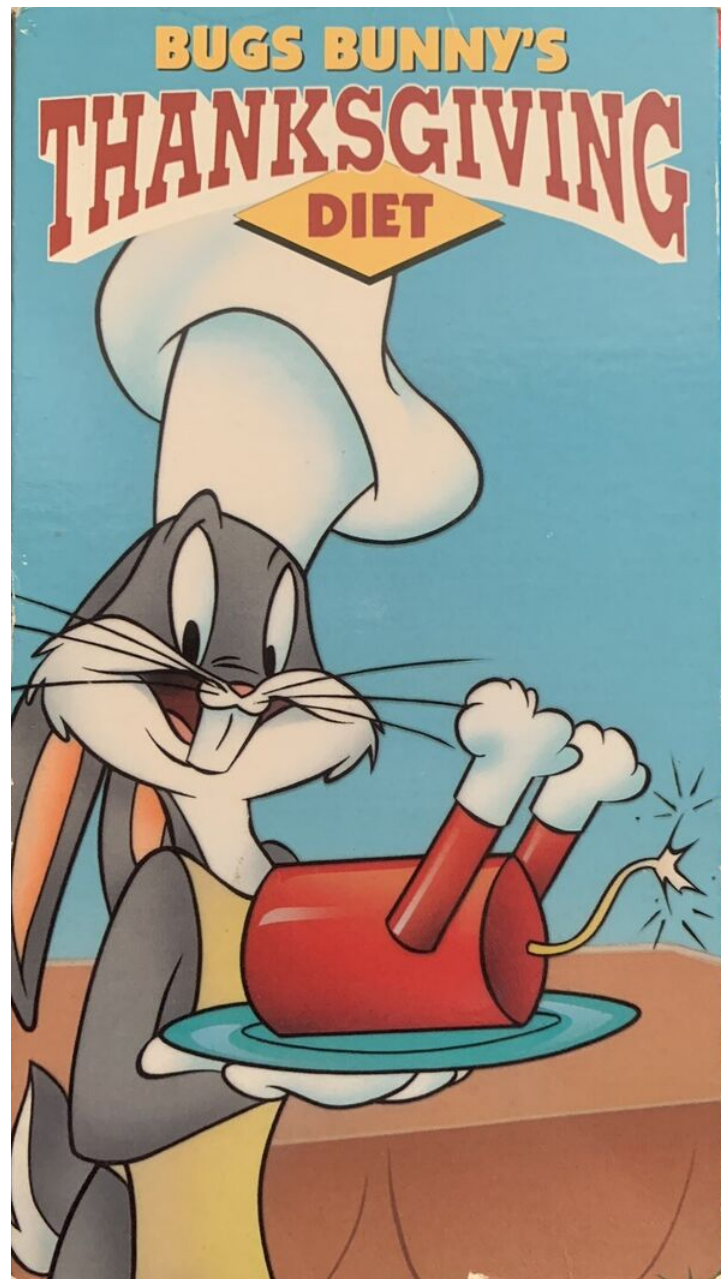
Hospitality: Candy can set up Friday night. She could use some help.

SWEET POTATOES

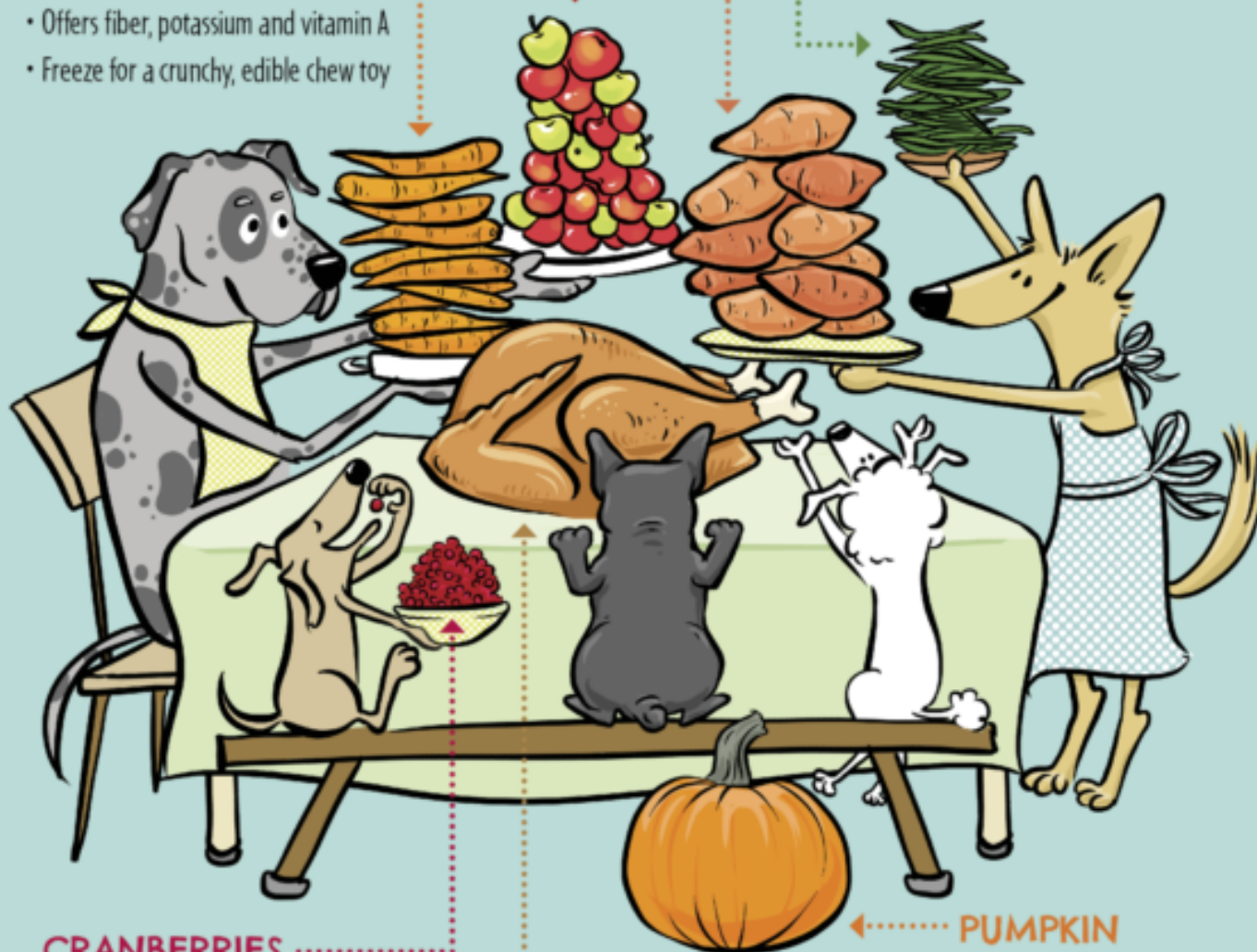
- Great source of fiber

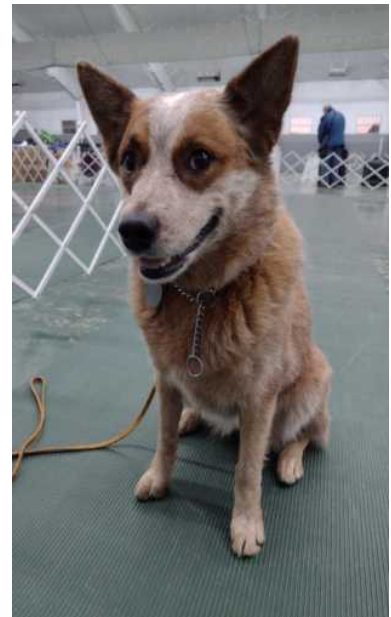
