Member Highlight[~] Cris Mazza



I moved to Illinois from California in 1993, but didn't join Glenbard until 2 years ago. I was impressed with how friendly all the "Glenbard folks" are at trials, so I decided to join the club. 




You are one of the most amazing of all creatures. And yet you are "just" a dog. Four paws and a whole lotta fur.




