


Byron Holtzen - President

Treat Timing is Everything

Giving our dogs a tasty treat for a job well done is the fun part of training for us and for our dogs! The positive feedback and reinforcement for understanding what we are asking them to accomplish is a needed part of our communication. But as the saying goes, timing is everything.

Moreover, there is a time and a place for everything, and everything needs to be in its place. Both applies to our training our dogs.

Have you every thought about how many fronts and finishes there are in all the levels of competition and how many points can be won and lost at these important transitions in the performance? We all keep our fingers crossed that they won't miss a jump or a retrieve, but how much time do we spend thinking about straight fronts? What does this have to do with treats you may wonder.

Points to consider- when you execute your recall, do you treat your dog even if he is to one side or do you work the front and only reward if they are straight? When you finish your dog do you reward only a straight finish or reward even if your dog's rear is out on an angle leaning toward your right hand our pouch? If you are heeling and the dog sits behind or forged do you still reward with a treat because he sat or only reward those sits that are straight in correct heel position?

Timing- be sure to give that treat when the dog hits the straight mark IMMDEDIATELY! Provide the clarity to what front and heel means by providing those perfectly timed rewards when they are right on the money! When your dog is crooked, make sure to provide that direction to straight and when he finds it, REWARD! Close enough is only good in horseshoes!

Remember- timing is everything so when he gets it right- JACKPOT right now! When he gets it wrong- good try buddy but try again. Rewarding the "close enough" will get you "close enough" scores but not what you really want. Make sure those treat and praise are right on target and so will your scores.
